

- O Consumer market estimated at \$150bn
- O Ecowas market has combined GDP of over \$600bn

- O Removal of import duty on select manufacturing machinery
- O Nigeria is a leading African economy with \$405bn GDP
- Government funding available to manufacturers modernising and retooling
- O Nigeria Food & Beverage sector is estimated to be worth \$19.5bn
- O Nigeria Food & Beverage sector is largest segment of manufacturing industry comprising 22.5%
- O Nigeria imported \$100m of plastics machinery in 2015

- O The market consists of 3,000 companies and a production capacity of over 100,000 tons p/a
- Nigerian Manufacturing Sector has had 6 consecutive months of growth since March 2017

- O Forex policy of February 2017 narrows gap between parallel and official exchange rates making forex more available to manufacturers


